Game Format for U6

- Girls: 3v3 ; Boys: 4v4 (3v3 if needed)
- Two goals for each team at each end
 - Located just outside the painted goal box
- Kick-ins
- Goal kicks – taken from goal box, opponents retreat to center circle
- Corner kicks – taken from closest corner or the center of the goal-line (between the goals)
- Parent referee



Game Format for U7-U8

- 5v5 (4 + GK)
- Throw-ins
- Corner kicks with flags
- “Build-out” line (half)
- No-Go goal area
- Goal kicks taken anywhere in semi-circle
- Club referees

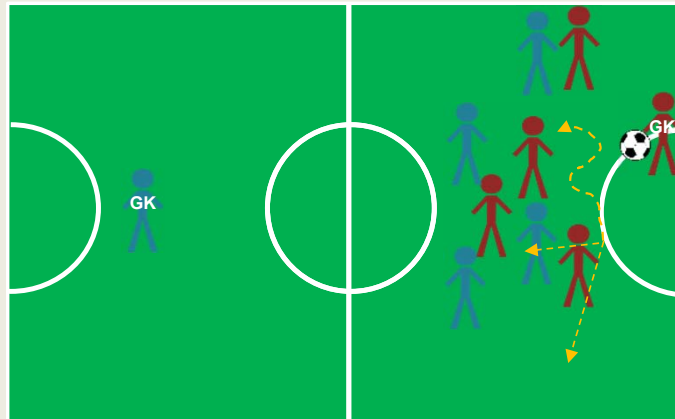
Protecting the Goalie

If a player from either team, other than the GK, plays the ball in the No-Go goal area, the resulting restart is a goal-kick



Build-Out Line (U7-8 - 5v5)

All opposing players must retreat to the half-way line whenever the GK has possession of the ball (in hands or goal kicks).
They may not advance till the ball has left the No-Go zone

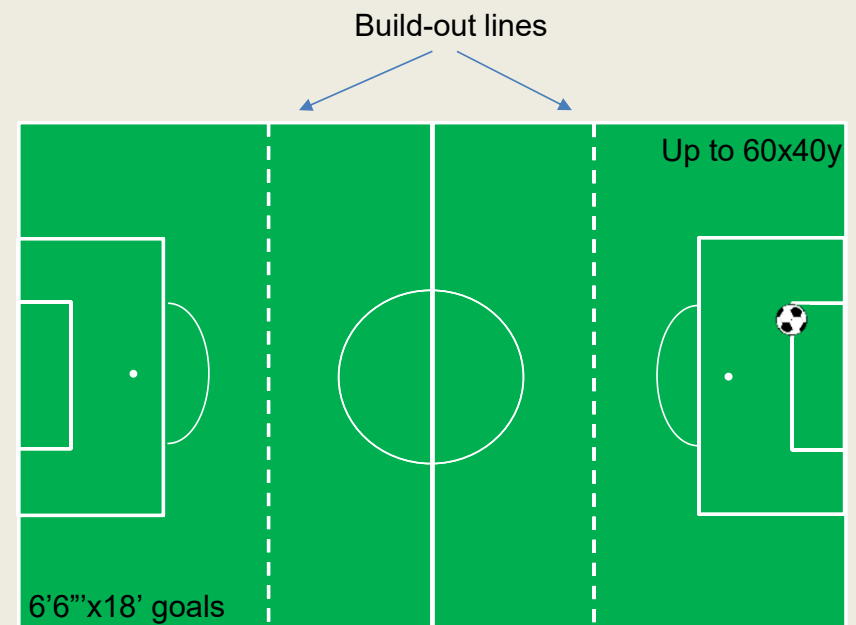


NOTE - GK is not allowed to punt or drop-kick the ball.
They must throw, roll, pass or dribble the ball into play.



Game Format for U10

- 7v7 (6+GK)
 - U10G: 7v7 (but 6v6 if needed)
- Build-out lines are now painted on the field
 - Halfway between center circle and top of penalty box
- Offside law – only if “obvious” to the ref
 - Furthest build-out line is new offside line
 - Reminder - U10 is a single-ref system
- Penalty area + Goal box
 - No more No-Go zone
 - Goal kicks are taken from goal box
- Direct and Indirect Free Kicks



NOTE - GK is not allowed to punt or drop-kick the ball.
Must throw, roll, pass or dribble the ball into play.

If no build-out line is marked,
then the edge of the center circle
will represent the build-out line



Game Formats – U12+

U12

- 9 v 9 (8 + GK)
- 75 x 45-yd field, 6'6" x 18' goals
- No build-out lines
- + **Assistant Referees** (FIFA offside, substitutions)

U14+

- 11 v 11
- up to 110x80 field (110x60), 8' x 24' goals
- **Heading allowed**
- **FIFA laws**

Coaches bring Pugg goals to all games

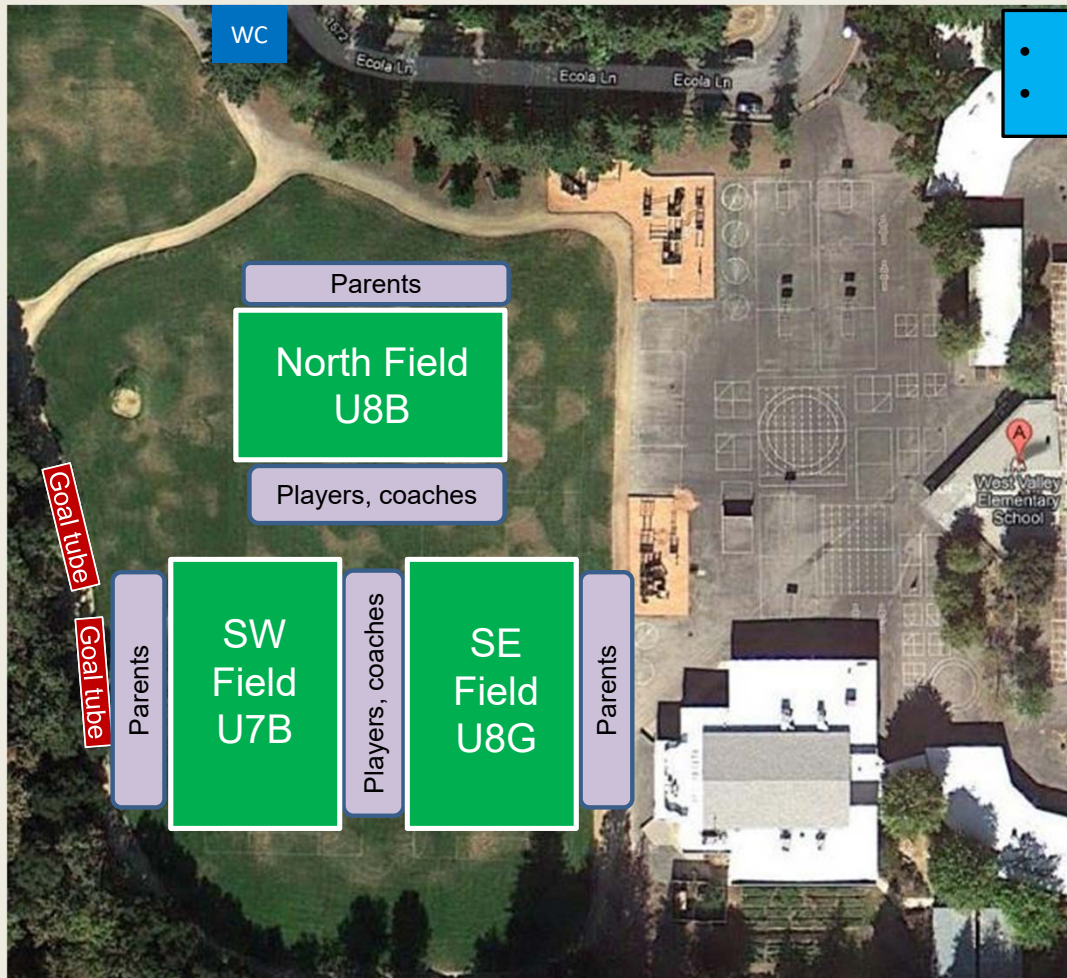


Referees

- All U6 games are refereed by parent refs (Not the coach)
- Each team needs to have one parent attend preseason referee training (Not the coach)



U7/8 - West Valley Elementary



- First teams set up goals, unlock port-a-pottie
- Last teams take down goals, lock port-a-pottie

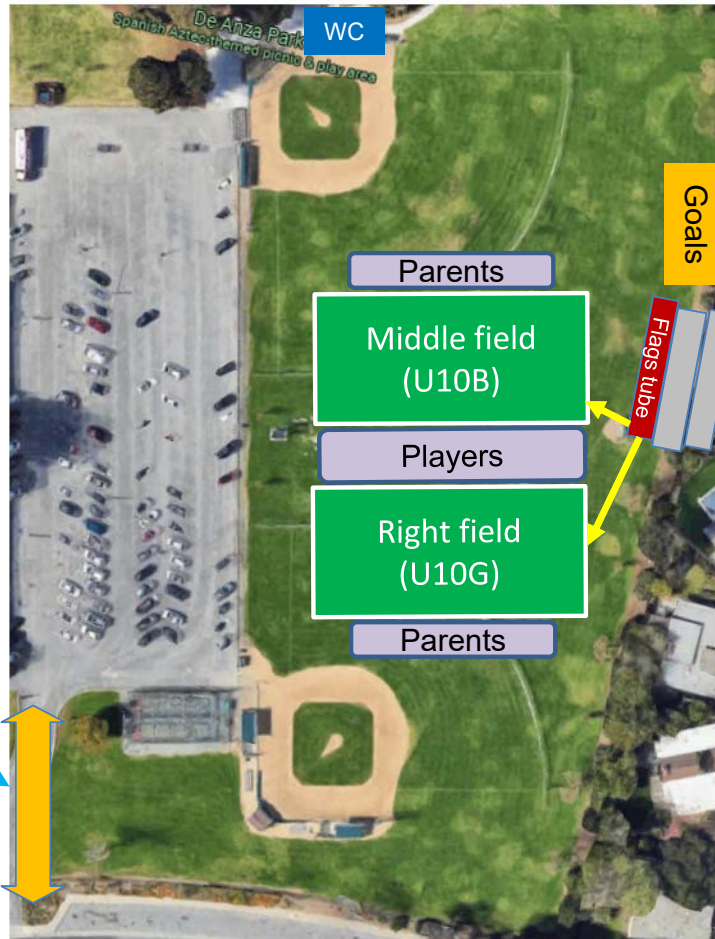
Referees

- Our goal is to have all U7/8 games refereed by club referees (usually brand-new 'professional' teenagers)
- It's possible we won't be able to cover all games, so each team needs to have one parent (not the coach) willing to step in to referee.

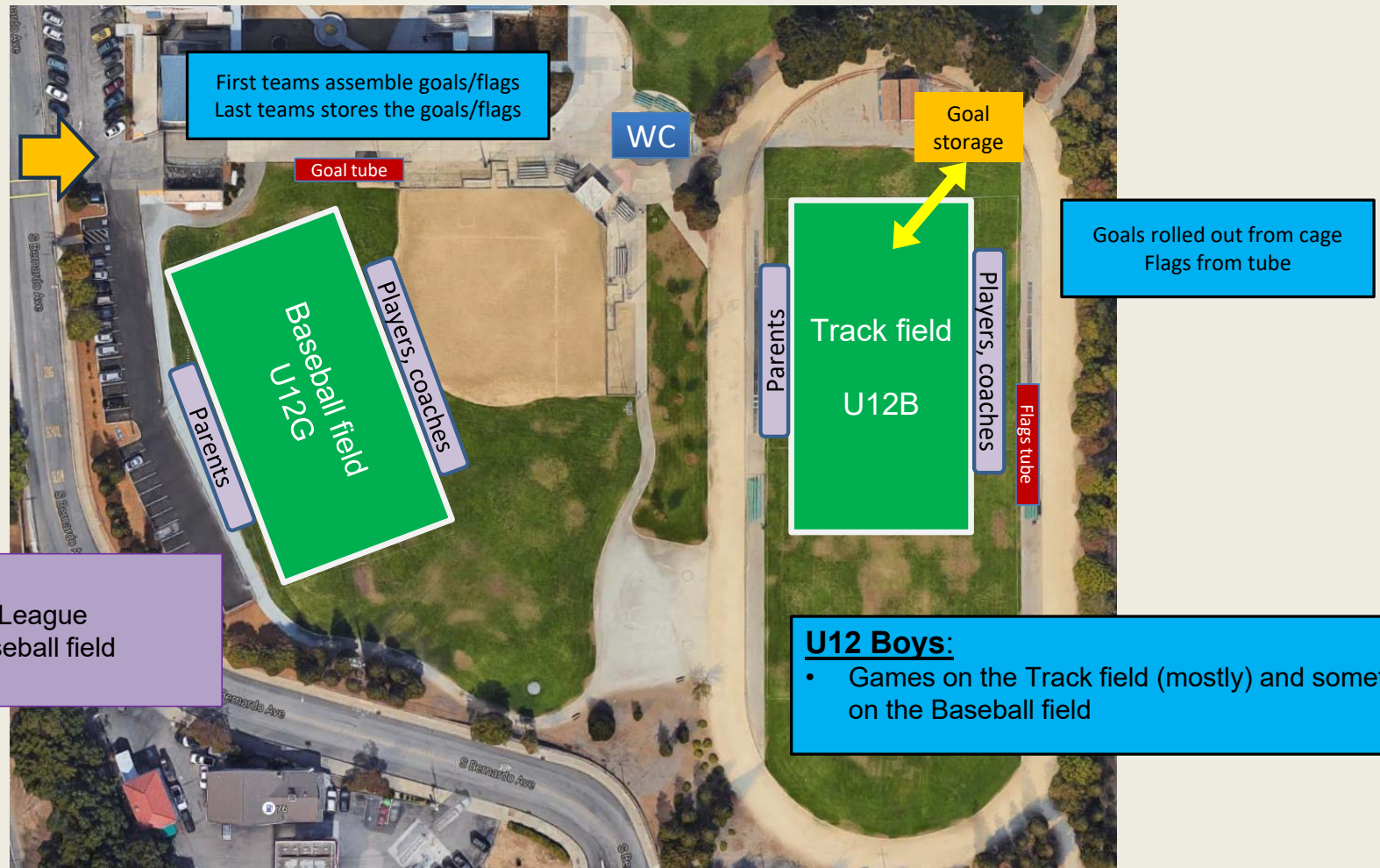


(NEW) Goals for both fields

U12 Girls:

- Games on the Track field (mostly) and sometimes on the Baseball field



U14+ (11v11) Columbia Middle School

(Home games only)



U14B, U14G, U16B, U16G (9 teams total)

All home games at Columbia Middle School

(Usually the South field. SASC competitive teams will often be using the North field)

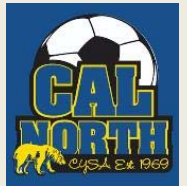
First teams rolls out goals/flags, unlock tube
(corner flags in the marked tube)
Last teams return the goals/flags, lock tube

If no one is warming up after you, then store the goals
All games will normally be bunched together



NorCal “Super Rec” League & CalNorth “PlayThrough” League

- Home & Away games
- Games could be any time on Saturday (AM or PM)
- Assignment of game times & locations:
 - SASC assigns your home games
 - Opponents assign your away games
- You must set up both goals for home games
 - Please allow sufficient time for your visiting opponent to have use of a goal before the game



No player passes required
Bring a printed roster to each game (for the referee)

Please remember - it's a rec league!
No scores/standings kept, and good behavior expected

Game Day Procedures

Lock Box

- Contains the key for the tubes & port-a-pottie (if applicable)
- Combination will be provided
- **MAKE SURE YOU IMMEDIATELY RETURN THE KEY TO THE LOCK BOX**

Port-a-potties

- First game: **unlock**, Last game: **lock**

Goal Assembly (U7 – U12)

- First game unlock tubes and erect goals and corner flags
- Last game make sure goals/flags are put away and tubes locked
- **Goals must be fully-anchored (minimum 4 anchors per goal)**
- Detailed assembly instructions for each field is on our website (and in the tube)
- Make sure painting equipment is kept easily available (put back last)

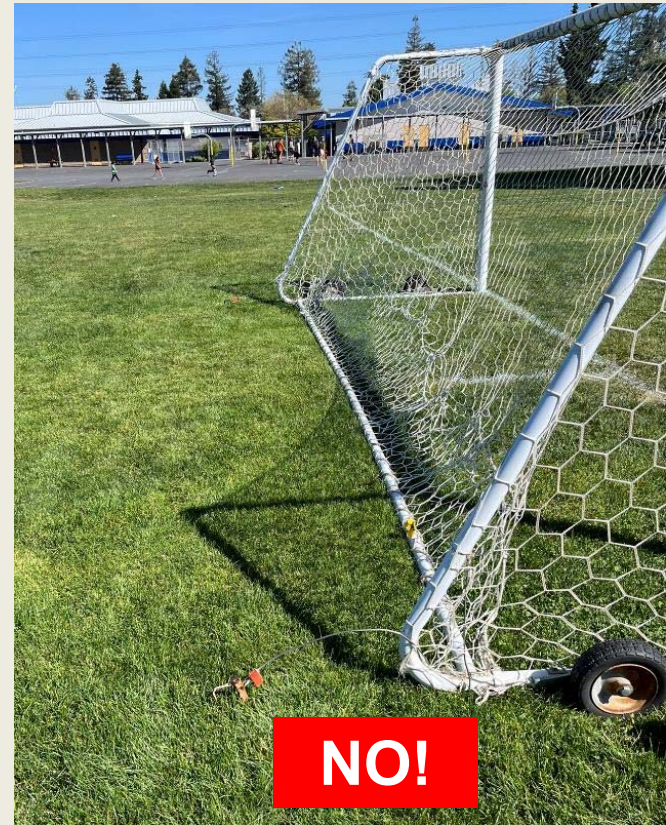


Please anchor the goals!!!

The purpose of the anchor is to stop the goal from tipping over (onto a child)
Make sure parents who are assembling goals are aware of this



Mallets are ONLY for putting stakes in the ground, NOT for assembling goals



Roll-out goals



Roll-outs used for:

- U12 (Cupertino Middle School - Track Field)
- U14+ (Columbia Middle School)

Must be stored at specified location (and locked!)



Field Safety (Boundaries)

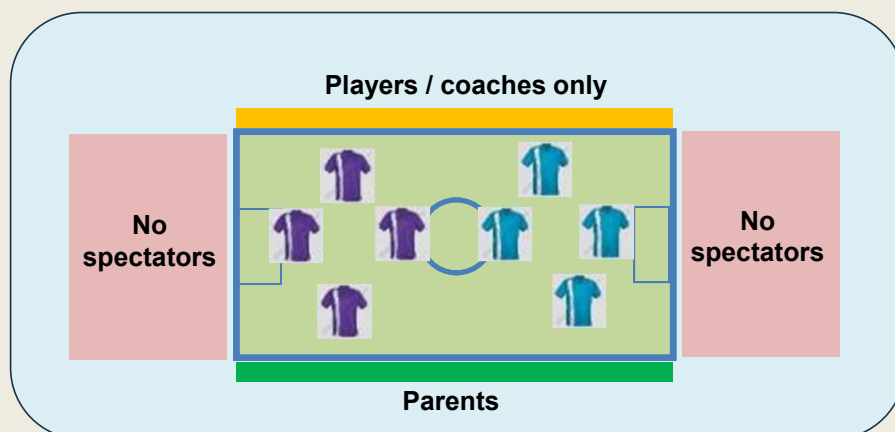


Is the field safe?

- Are goals anchored?
- Check field (sticks, holes, dogs...)
- Sideline “buffer” zone?

Is the environment safe?

- Players only on the field?
- Is it “safe” to attack the goal?
- Parents on opposite side of field to players?



Rules for Refereed games (U7+)

- Unlimited subbing at any stoppage - with the permission of the referee
 - Coaches must have subs ready at the half line to prevent delaying the game
- No heading is permitted until U14+
- No slide tackling is permitted until U12+
 - Only 'clean' slide tackling is allowed. Any attempt to slide tackle with cleats up, or using both feet, or from behind will result in a yellow card
 - Any hard or dangerous contact with an opponent is a red card
- No jewelry
 - Earrings, bracelets, necklaces, rings, nose-rings etc. not permitted
 - Earrings with tape will not be permitted
- Shin-guards must be covered by socks
- Missing referee
 - Coaches should be prepared to provide a referee if one does not arrive by scheduled kick-off time
- SASC Referees will not be implementing the new IFAB speed-of-play laws

Ref's call is always the 'official' call, regardless of what others think



Officials / Referees



Why do we train them?

- Good club reputation
- When/where else would they learn?
- Retention rate (low %)

What if it were your kid refereeing?

- Would you shout?

Does it matter?

- Goal-kick vs. Corner-kick?
- Free-kick (us/them?)
- Throw-in (us/them?)

***Remember...
it's just kids playing a game!***



Game Cancellations / Reschedules

- The City of Sunnyvale decides whether fields are closed for rain (early Saturday AM)
- If fields are closed, all games are cancelled
- Field status is posted on SASC homepage, emailed via BYGA

SASC will also stop activities if air-quality is poor

- No official make-up games for cancellations
- This is a recreational league, and we don't support reschedules in the same way as competitive leagues
- Two coaches may mutually agree to cancel their scheduled game **if absolutely necessary**
 - You may choose to play at another time or place. However, SASC cannot provide a field or referees for such a game
 - We always urge you to play the game – even with less players
- **For any cancellation or change, you must contact the Rec Game Scheduler by Wednesday prior to your game in order for the referee(s) to be officially informed**
- Please do NOT ever contact the Referee Assigner directly

Practices

Practice Expectations:

- U6 once per week, 45-60 minutes
 - U7-8 once per week, up to 60 minutes
 - U10 once per week, 60 minutes
 - U12+ once-twice per week, 60-90 minutes
-
- SASC has permits for several city fields for the season
 - These are unassigned – shared by interested SASC teams
 - Work with other coaches to find a fit/train alongside
-
- You can also practice on fields other than above, but...
 - Must be in Sunnyvale City limits or check with Rec Coordinator
 - Must yield to other users of fields who have a permit (incl. SASC comp teams)

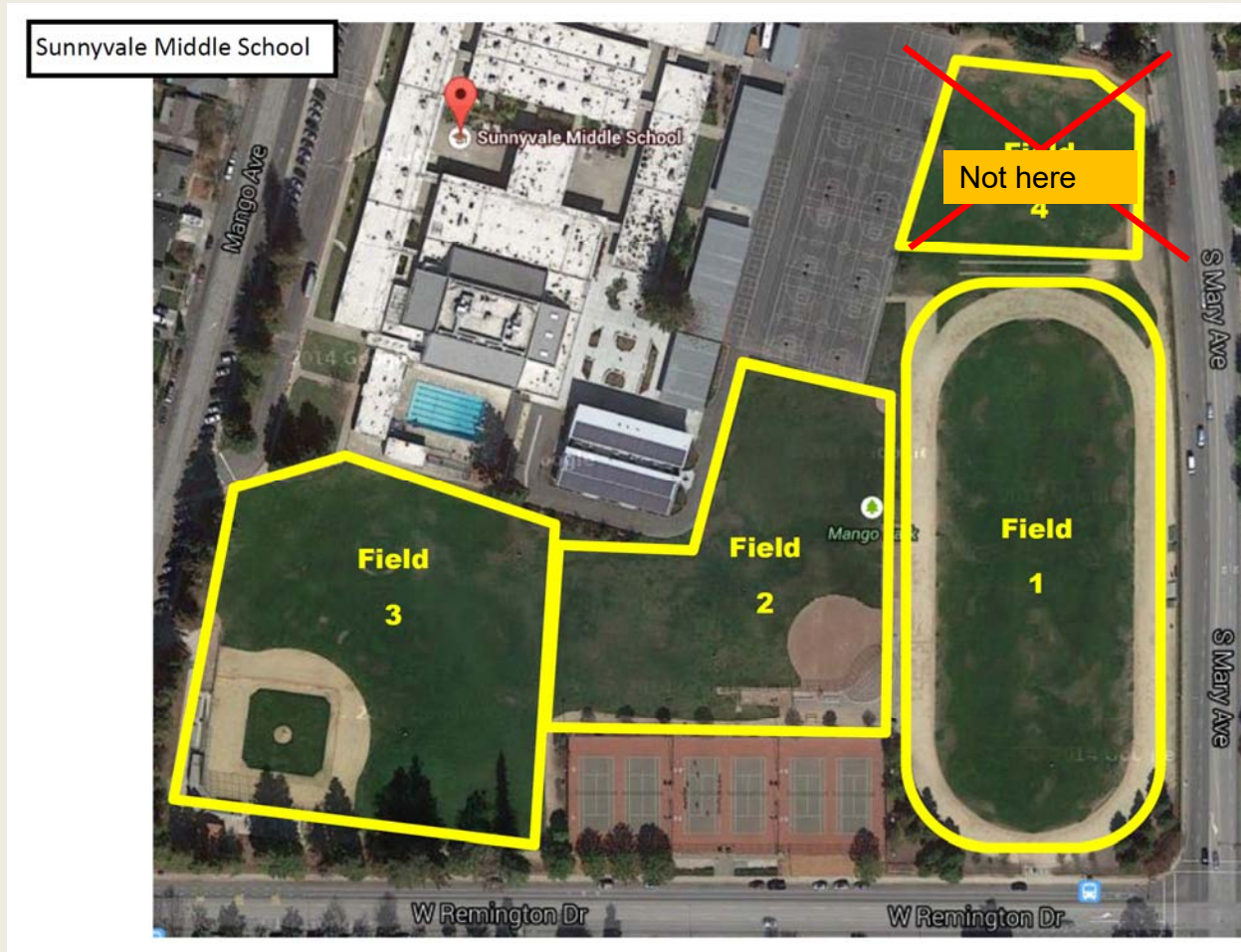

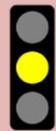


Penultimate Player Policy

Penultimate player policy:

Coach cannot be alone with any player (except their own child)

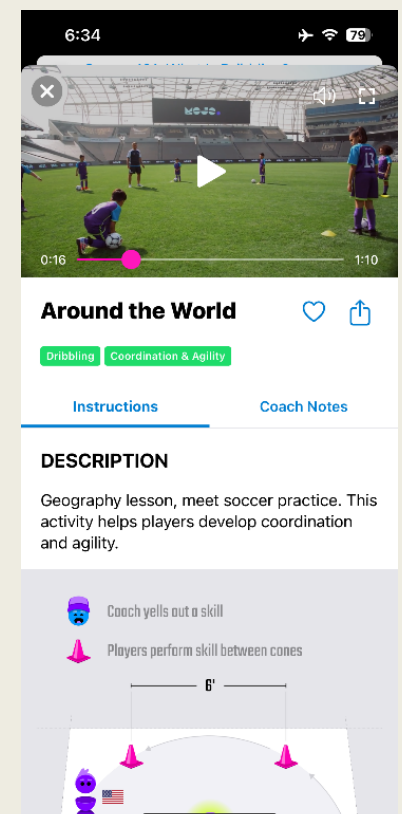
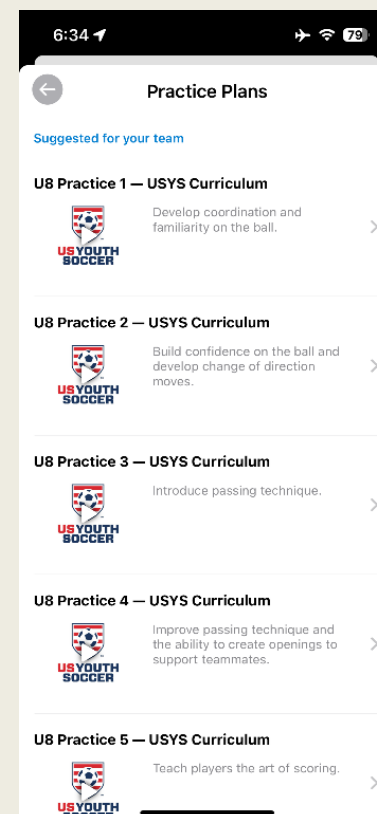
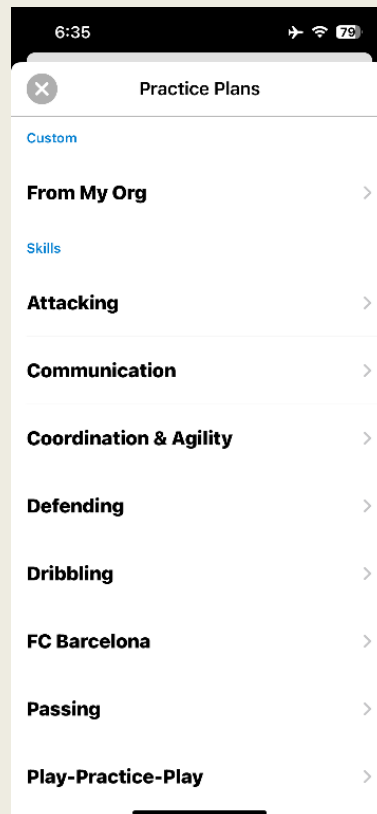
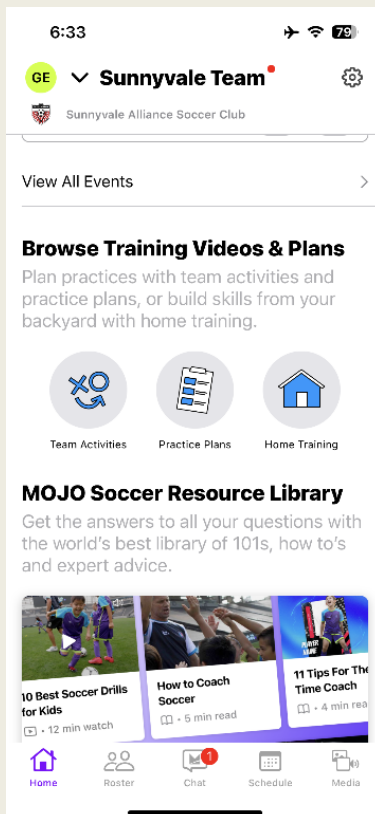
Safety & Risk Management

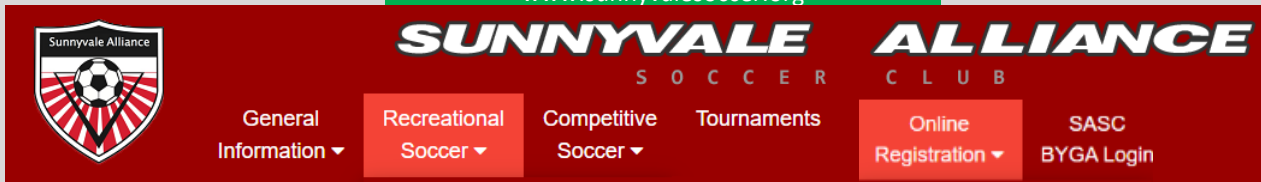

Field Setup/Takedown

- Get key from lockbox and unlock the portapotties
- Unhook storage tube to retrieve goals and 4 corner flags and return key to lockbox
- Assemble goals and put up corner flags
- Anchor goals by using the 4 stakes. A stake is in the bag if you need it.

Last game of the day is responsible for putting away!

- Disassemble goals and return put them back in the bags and then in the tubes. *Note: When putting away the goals in Tube 1, please put the goal and cone in the bag.
- Lock storage tube and portapotties. Make sure the key is returned to the lockbox.
